In 2025, SFHA will celebrate its fiftieth anniversary – as will many of our members. Our members are uniquely positioned as community anchors across Scotland, supporting people and their communities.


3. Our mission

Representing Everyone


We are broadening and deepening our relationships with members, aiming to support their staff at all levels and from every background.
